



## What is the Otley Road Sustainable Transport Package?

- £565k funding from the National Productivity Investment fund (NPIF) to spend in the vicinity of the Otley road corridor to reduce congestion and enhance Active Travel opportunities.
- NPIF £4.6 million
  - -Package of sustainable measures to alleviate congestion, improve safety along the Otley Road corridor.
  - -Consisted of rural maintenance upgrades, signal upgrades, junction widening at Harlow Moor road and introduction of phase 1 cycle route.
  - Phase 2 cycle route not to be progressed, recognised the constraints an alternative solution was to introduce the Otley road sustainable Transport package.








### **Timescales**

- A proposed package of schemes to be presented to Harrogate and Knaresborough Area Constituency July/Aug23 (since the presentation ACC date confirmed September 23)
- Environment Services Executive members meeting September
  23
- Design and implementation from Autumn 23 onwards.
