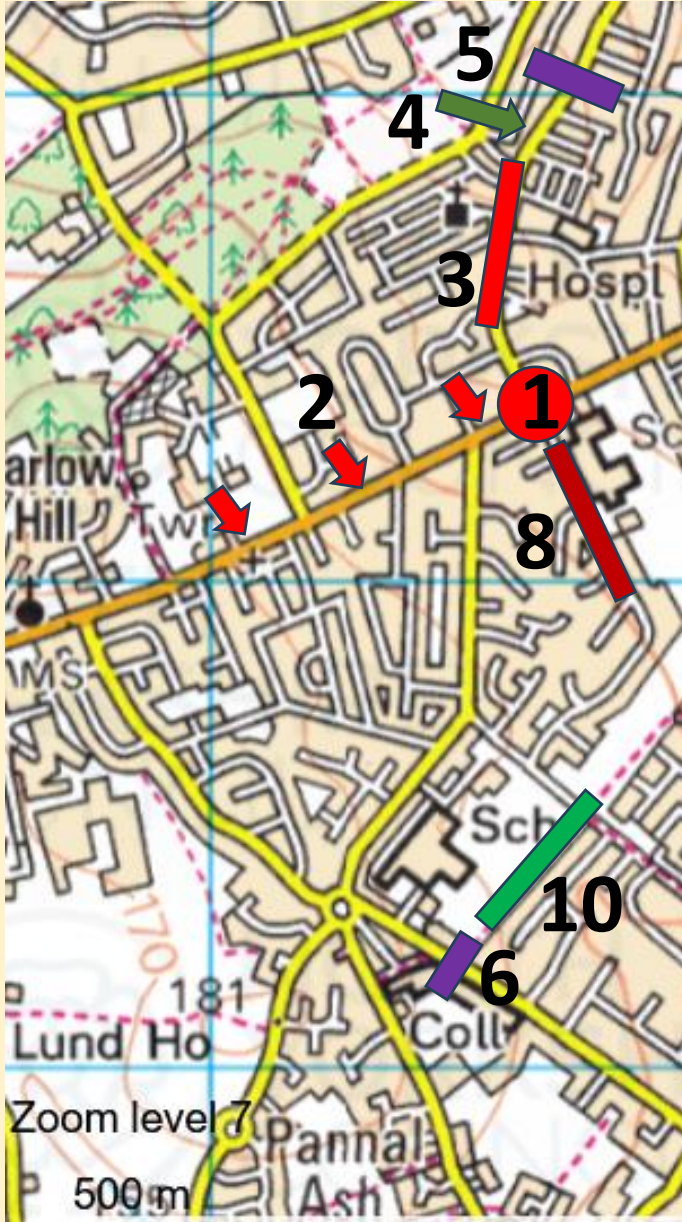

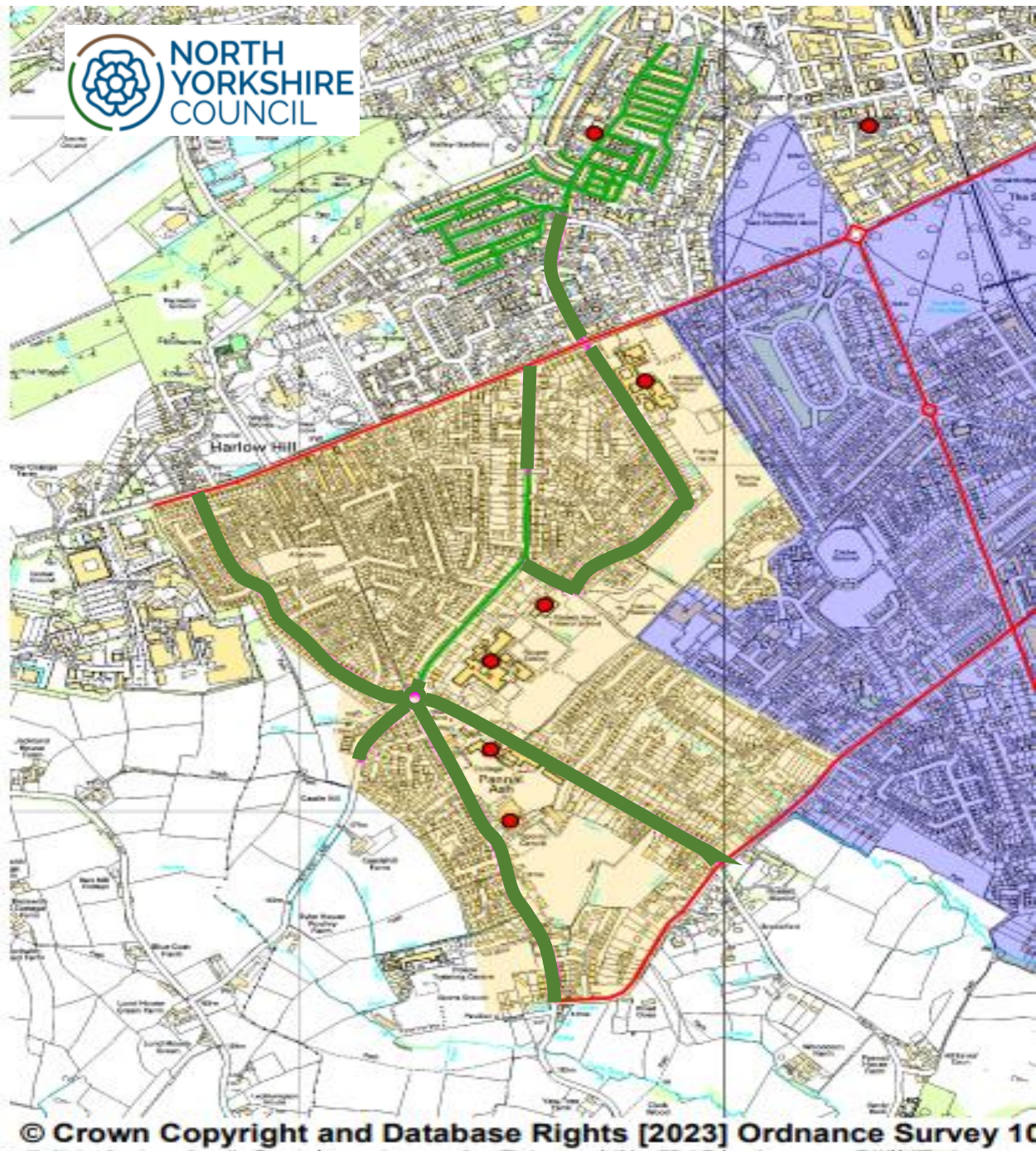

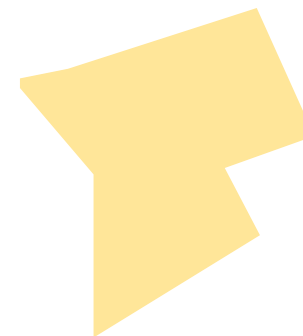

October 2024	TRO drawing and full signing and lining schedules being amended at present – including all road lighting work	Ongoing
October 2024	Instruct legal to advertise once police comments received	Mid October
November 2024	Advertising of the Orders	
December 2024	Advertising of the Orders	
December 2024/ January 2025	If no objections, works orders will be raised with the contractors - target for delivery on site is the end of the financial year but this is subject to confirmation of agreed Traffic Regulation Orders and a further programme will be shared in the new year

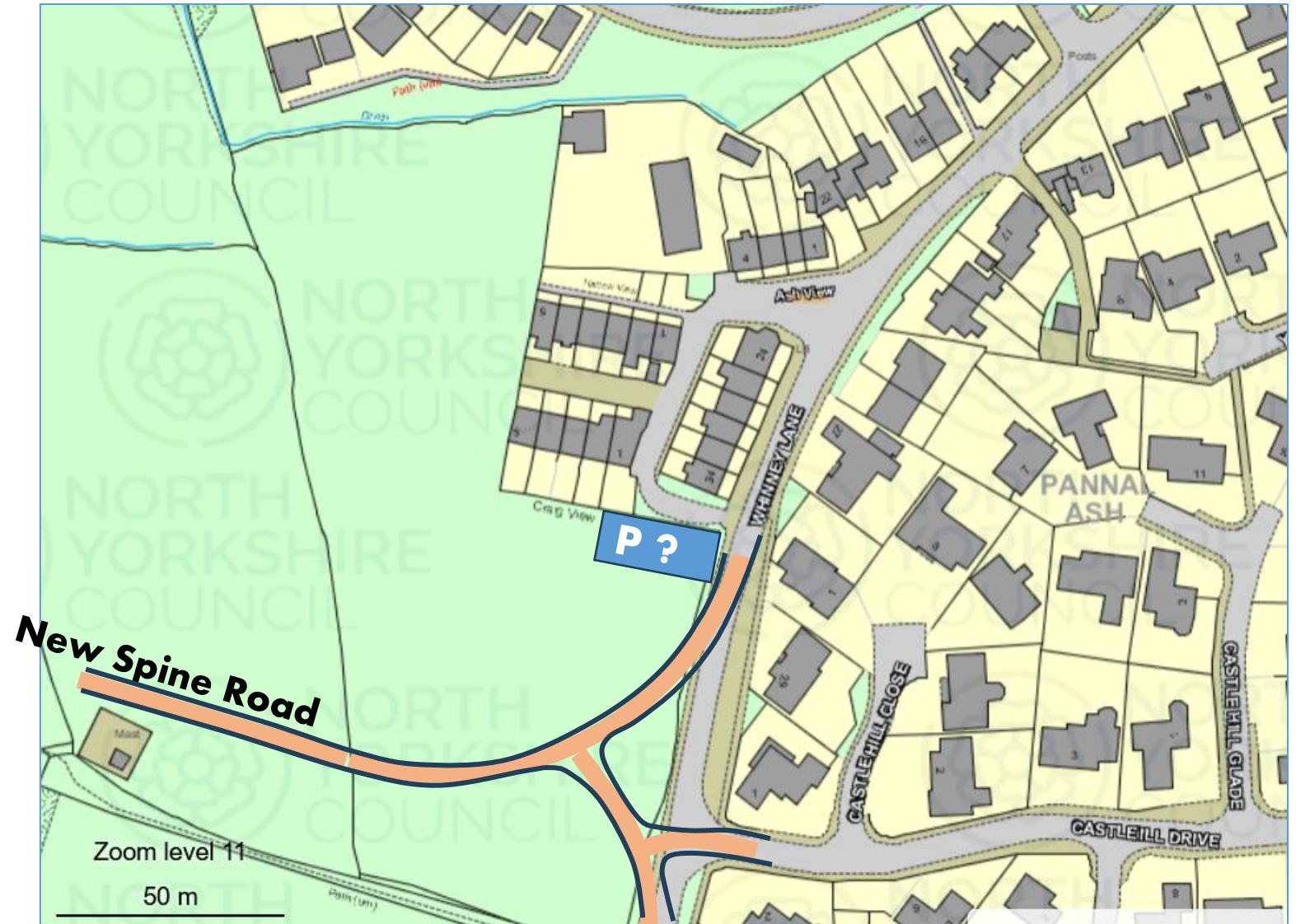
